- --Discussed the use of real teddys against the use of numbered laminated teddy shapes for the teddy hunt TJ to pursue
- -- content of advertising poster agreed and that it would be displayed fro1st April.
- -- agreed that any organisation wanting to put a stall could do so
- -- TJ reported Coast Guard subject to HQ approval would be present he had yet to confirm Fire Service presence.
- -- need to confirm a police presence PO to contact police. KS suggested asking if they could also put up a stall or give demo /interactive event as they are in other areas PO to ask.
