#### 36(19-20) Commonwealth Day

**Resolved:** For an article to be placed in the Focus magazine informing the public of the date of the event next year. Once the theme for 2020 is announced, invitations to be sent out to schools and local organisations.

### 37(19-20) Christmas lights switch-on

Issues regarding the public venturing outside the barriers and the availability of marshals and stewards on the day were discussed. The clerk stated that without the correct number of marshals and stewards available she would be unable to close the road. The lengthsman's absence was also raised and the need for assistance with the erection of the Christmas tree and the placing of the barriers. It was confirmed that help would be available from the gala volunteers for marshalling and a request would be made for councillors to help.
