At the request of the Mayor, councillors **resolved** to adjourn the meeting to allow non-councillors to speak.

The council heard the sequence of events leading up to the allegation of damage to the roof of a vehicle parked on the Playing Fields car park and had the opportunity to question the lengthsman regarding his written statement.

At the conclusion of the public participation and at the request of the Mayor, councillors **resolved** to reconvene the meeting.

(16-17)100 Damage to Car on Playing Field Car Park

After having heard the evidence of the lengthsman, the council received feedback from The Mayor and Town Clerk re their visit to see the vehicle owned by the complainant. Two quotes for the repair of the vehicle were presented to the council, each for the same amount. Councillors also discussed the lack of signage at the car park informing the public of parking rights.

RESOLVED:

- 1) To settle the invoice without prejudice for the removal of scratches from the roof of the vehicle (owner of vehicle to choose garage for repair as both quotes are for the same amount £150)**
- 2) To pursue the erection of signage by Wyre Council on the car park. Councillor Orme to speak with Carl Green re the form of words to be included on the signs and the painting of a hatched area behind the gate.**
- 3) That the lengthsman put up temporary signage, kindly donated by Councillor Campbell, until a permanent solution is agreed with Wyre Council.**

There being no other business the Mayor closed the meeting at 7.35pm.
